Clothing and Equipment Recommendations List

- 1) Boots- All boots for winter operations should be rated to at least -70 degrees Celsius. Boots should come up to approximately the middle of your calf and provide good ankle support. **All boots should be CSA approved.** Recommended brands are Baffin and Dunlop.
- 2) Socks- Wool socks are recommended. Spare socks should be packed in order to have a dry pair available to change into.
- 3) Clothing Layers-
 - a. Wicking layer- the layer of clothing closest to a worker's body should be of a material that will wick moisture away from the body. Recommended materials are wool, silk polypropylene and other synthetic materials
 - b. Insulation layer- the layers of clothing used to help maintain the body heat of workers. Multiple layers are recommended and should be of materials such as fleece or wool. **Certain job sites have banned hoodies. Please consult with management to determine if you are affected by this.**
 - c. Protective Layer- this is the outermost layer on the workers body and should be wind and waterproof. Durable winter work coats and insulated coveralls are recommended.
- 4) Gloves- Should be well insulated and provide enough mobility to complete all job-related tasks. Spare pairs of gloves should be packed in order to have a dry pair available to change into. Please note, cotton-based gloves should not be used as an external layer.
- 5) Backpack- Workers must have a backpack to bring to work to pack extra clothing, as well as daily supplies including lunch and fluids. Workers should avoid using large camping style backpacks and instead utilize a smaller type of backpack. Workers are encouraged to utilize re-usable water bottles in an effort to reduce our impact on the environment.

Personal Identification Requirements

- 1) Current photo identification/driver's license
- 2) Social insurance number
- 3) Provincial health care card number
- 4) Void cheque or direct deposit information.
- 5) Cash/debit card/credit card to cover miscellaneous expenses.

Additional Packing Requirements

- 1) Alarm clock
- 2) Personal hygiene supplies (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap)
- 3) Shower sandals
- 4) Physical copies of all current and applicable training certifications including Standard First Aid and CPR and H2S Alive.
